

Download Al Tawhid: Its Implications For Thought And Life

Tawhid (Arabic: تَوْحِيدٌ ? taw??d, meaning "oneness [of God]" also romanized as tawheed, touheed, or tevhid) is the indivisible oneness concept of monotheism in Islam. Tawhid is the religion's central and single-most important concept, upon which a Muslim's entire faith rests. The purpose of this article is to outline the delineating features of a Qur'an-Sunnah hermeneutic of one of the contemporary Muslim schools of thought, here named Neo-traditional Salafism (NTS).
