Reynolds is a surname in the English language. Among the earliest recorded use of the surname is from the early 14th century; Walter Reynolds of Worcester, England. Spencer (also Spence, Spender, Spens, and Spenser) is a surname, representing the court title dispenser, or steward. An early example is Robert d'Abbetot, who is listed as Robert le Dispenser ('the steward'), a tenant-in-chief of several counties, in the Domesday Book of 1086.
