Free improvisation or free music is improvised music without any rules beyond the logic or inclination of the musician(s) involved. The term can refer to both a technique (employed by any musician in any genre) and as a recognizable genre in its own right. A jazz band (jazz ensemble or jazz combo) is a musical ensemble that plays jazz music.
