

Download Nowhere Man The Final Days Of John Lennon

"Nowhere Man" is a song by the English rock band the Beatles. It was released in December 1965 on their album Rubber Soul, except for in the United States and Canada, where it was first issued as a single A-side in February 1966 before appearing on the album Yesterday and Today. Originally released on Rubber Soul in the UK, Nowhere Man was born of John Lennon's sense of isolation in his Weybridge home. "I'd spent five hours that morning trying to write a song that was meaningful and good and I finally gave up and lay down. Then Nowhere Man came, words and music, the whole damn thing." "NOWHERE MAN" (John Lennon – Paul McCartney) It's seems hard to believe, but it's true. As was common for pop songwriting of the late 50's and early 60's, which was the template for Lennon and McCartney's early songwriting, the subject of choice for The Beatles' original material always seemed to center around a relationship ...It began with the bet. Elton John sang and played piano on both "Surprise Surprise (Sweet Bird of Paradox)" and "Whatever Gets You Thru the Night" for Lennon's 1974 album Walls and Bridges.
